- HTML is a markup language used to create static web pages and web applications. CSS is a style sheet language responsible for the presentation of documents written in a markup language.
- Cascading Style Sheets (CSS) is a style sheet language used for specifying the presentation and styling of a document written in a markup language such as HTML or XML
- Adobe Dreamweaver is a website creation program that allows you to build and publish web pages almost anywhere with software that supports HTML, CSS, JavaScript and more. Dreamweaver is useful for a variety of web designers, from beginners to advanced professionals.
